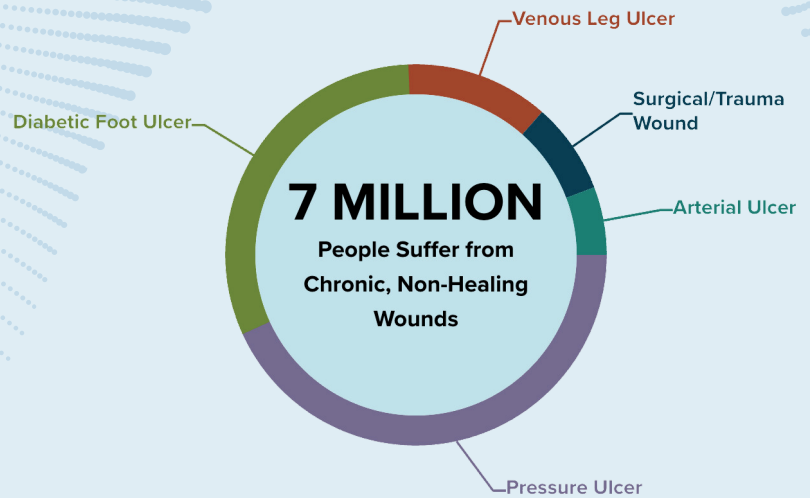


Wound care is important because chronic wounds can have serious consequences.
